### **IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE**

2 mo.	Pediatric (Dtap, IPV, Hepatitis B); Hib; Prevnar, RotaTeq (if meets age requirements)
4 mo.	Pediatric (Dtap, IPV, Hepatitis B); Hib; Prevnar, RotaTeq (if meets age requirements)
6 mo.	Pediatric (Dtap, IPV, Hepatitis B); Prevnar, RotaTeq (if meets age requirements)
12 mo.	Hib, Prevnar, Hepatitis A
15 mo.	MMR, Varicella
18 mo.	Dtap, Hepatitis A
4-6 yrs	Dtap, IPV, MMR, Varicella
11-12 yrs	Tdap, Menactra

### **Influenza Vaccine**

- Given yearly at age 6 mo and older (starting around September – October each year)
- For children younger than 9 years old and have never received the influenza vaccine before or were vaccinated for the first time last year but only received 1 dose then they will need 2 doses separated by 4 wks or longer.

### **Recommended vaccines but not required**

Girls 11 years and older

- Gardasil (protection against certain types of cervical cancer)

NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING “SPACING” RULES APPLY:

- There must be at minimum 2 months between the “2 mo.” and “4 mo.” set of shots.
- There must be at minimum 2 months between the “4 mo.” and “6 mo.” set of shots.
- 12 month shots must be given at least 1 day AFTER the first birthday.
- There must be at minimum 6 months between the “12 mo.” and the “18 mo.” set of shots.
- Gardasil is a 3 dose series
  1. 1<sup>st</sup> dose given as early as age 9 (we recommend between 11 and 12).
  2. 2<sup>nd</sup> dose given 2 months after 1<sup>st</sup> dose.
  3. 3<sup>rd</sup> dose given 4 months after 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

ALSO note that we must supply our own Gardasil and Menactra for patients who do NOT qualify for the “vaccine for children” program as defined by the state (ie., they do not have MDD / DKC or are not Alaska Native or uninsured). These vaccines can be expensive and may not be covered by all insurance plans.
